Wills/Bequests

Legacy gifts are an especially meaningful way to help the Bayfield Regional Conservancy protect land for generations to come. The most widely chosen method of leaving a legacy gift is to remember BRC in your will or living trust.

Making a bequest to BRC in your will.

You can specify a dollar amount, specific assets, or a specify a percentage of your estate. You may similarly name BRC the beneficiary of your living trust. You may also want to name BRC the contingent beneficiary of a bequest intended for a surviving loved one, in the event that he or she does not survive you.

Sample Bequest Language

To make a bequest, consult with your legal advisor and have a phrase such as the following, that includes BRC's legal designation, inserted in your will or added as a codicil. BRC's tax ID number is 39-1872550.

"I give, devise, and bequeath to The Bayfield Regional Conservancy, a Wisconsin nonprofit charitable organization, with business address of 121 Manypenny Street, Bayfield, Wisconsin 54814, the sum of _____ dollars [or otherwise describe the gift or assets] for its general purposes and use at the discretion of The Bayfield Regional Conservancy's Board of Directors."

Mission Statement: *The Bayfield Regional Conservancy is a locally based non-profit land trust dedicated to the permanent protection of natural and scenic areas, lakeshores, rivers, wetlands, forests and farmlands for their aesthetic and ecologic value.
